Schedule

Feeding/Cleaning

- 1. You will be responsible for feeding your dog it's food and water everyday unless other arrangements have been made.
- 2. Additional duties must be completed on a weekly basis. These duties include washing all bowls, refilling your treat container, raking/cleaning poopies and washing toys, leashes, etc.

Team Training

- 1. Submit rabies shot records to Mrs. Hessel prior to practice.
- 2. Aggressive dogs will be removed from the team.
- 3. Practices will be held on Tuesday and Thursday and could be a combination of mornings and afternoons.
- 4. Advanced notice is required if you have a conflict and you're not able to attend practice.
- 5. Please communicate via GroupMe.

Minimum Requirements

Competitions/Shows

Full participation is required for success. You should attend 2 practice shows, and most attend the Florida State Fair Youth Dog Show in February. This also includes the seminar and setup/teardown for this event.

Cost

Dog Project Fees

A project fee of \$35 payable to Martinez FFA Alumni will be due prior to your animal coming onto the land lab. These fees will be used to order team shirts and help with the general maintenance of the dog areas and equipment.

Additional Cost

- 1. All show fees are the responsibility of the student.
- 2. AKC Youth membership will be the responsibility of the individual member. Mixed breeds are registered as ALL AMERICAN.
